PDES, Inc. recently recognized Phil Rosche of ACCR, LLC, for his 34 years of service to the organization. Among his many contributions to PDES, Inc. was his seminal role in the development of the testing forum for the ISO 10303 standard. It began as a one-day event called plugfest, hosted by NIST. However, the value of testing the developing standard as a means to instill quality and ensure US Industry requirements became apparent. Mr. Rosche helped to create the Computer-aided X Implementor forum and user groups with the PDES, Inc. partners. His expertise led to colleagues requesting his assistance in standing up other testing forums for additional domains and culminated in his role as the leader of the model-based implementor forum group.

Mr. Rosche is solid believer in team collaboration and is noted for fostering camaraderie in a group that comes from diverse cultural backgrounds, many of whom speak English as a second language. He also believed pitching-in to help his colleagues wherever his assistance was needed.

Mr. Rosche is planning to retire in December 2024.
